Morphology :

An evergreen tree.It is a moderate-sized, glabrous tree about 18-20 m. height.

Stem Erect, woody, branched, thick, solid, cylindrical with grey bark.

Leaf Simple, opposite, stalked, 10-14 cm long, petiolate, exstipulate with reticulate venation, gland dotted

Flower White, small, crowded, on inflorescence, inferior ovary

Fruit - Berry, succulent, globose, dark purple,smooth when ripe.

Seed- Single, endospermic

Chemical Constituents :

Seed contains a glucoside – jamboline, ellagic acid, yellow essential oil, chlorophyll, resin, gallic acid, albssñrin etc.Bark has 12% gum.

Fruits eugenia triterpenoids A & B, oleanolic acid, malic acid, glucose, fructose, gallic acid

Stem bark & root- Kaempferol , myricetin, quercetin

Leaves- citric, oxalic and glycollic acids; glucose, leucine, sitosterol, dihydromyricetin etc.

anthocyanins , citric, malic ,gallic acids, and tannins

diabetes(seed), ulcer

Fruit, leaf, stem bark,seed

Fresh juice 25-50 ml; powder 4-6 g.
