7. **Information regarding Ombudsperson and Student Grievance Redressal Committees**

The University shall prominently publish on its website and the prospectus all relevant information in respect of the Student Grievance Redressal Committee(s) under its purview, and the Ombudsperson for the purpose of appeal (s)

8. **Group Grievance Redressal**


Redressal of Group grievances may pertain to the following:

- (a) Group grievances lodged together by several students shall be referred to the Head of the Department who will try and resolve the matter within a period of one week.
- (b) In case the students are not satisfied with the decision of the Head of Department, students may approach the Admission and Facilitation Cell for its consideration.
- (c) If the grievance remains unresolved within two weeks from the day the grievance was lodged with the Admission and Facilitation Cell, an appeal may be made to the Vice-Chancellor, who will try to resolve the matter.

The Decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final and binding.

10. **Redressal of Grievances related to the Accounts, Library, Hostels, Food, Maintenance, Sports and Security, etc.:**

- (a) The grievances pertaining to the Accounts Branch, Library, Hostels, Food, Maintenance, Sports, Security and related issues shall be lodged with the respective administrative Head/in-charge. The Heads shall personally look into the grievance(s) and settle it within a period of one week.
- (b) If a resolution is not provided within the said timeline; the student may approach the Admission and Facilitation Cell who will try to get the issue(s) resolved in a week's time.
- (c) If the matter remains unresolved after approaching the Facilitation Cell, the students may make an appeal to the Registrar who shall try to resolve the matter within a period of one week.
- (d) The decision of Registrar shall be final and binding.



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✓ 13. **ESTABLISHMENT OF COLLEGES/ CENTRES/ DEPARTMENTS**

- a. The University shall have such Colleges of Studies, Special Centres and Specialized

Laboratories as may be approved by the Executive Council.

b. The University shall have the following Colleges, namely:

- i. College of Agricultural Sciences
  - ii. College of Allied Health Sciences
  - iii. College of Architecture & Planning
  - iv. College of Basic Sciences & Research
  - v. College of Business Studies
  - vi. College of Dental Sciences
  - vii. College of Education
  - viii. College of Engineering & Technology
  - ix. College of Humanities & Social Sciences
  - x. College of Law
  - xi. College of Media, Film & Entertainment
  - xii. College of Medical Sciences & Research
  - xiii. College of Nursing Science & Research
  - xiv. College of Pharmacy
- c) Every College of Studies (here in after referred to as the College) shall consist of such Departments as may be assigned to it with the approval of the Executive Council.
- d) Each College/Centre/ Department shall have a Dean/ Director/ Head of the Department, respectively.
- e) Deans, Directors, and Head of Departments shall be appointed and perform functions as per the provisions in Section 10, 12, and 16 of the Statutes respectively.
- f) Every College shall have a Faculty Board (College Board) and each Department shall have a Board of Studies in accordance with Section 25 and 26 of the University Statutes.

#### **Establishment of Special University Units**

On the recommendations of the Academic Council, the Executive Council may establish Special Centre's and Specialized laboratories for undertaking Interdisciplinary and Special Studies Programmes including Centres of Excellence, Centres of Studies, Special Centres, Inter-disciplinary Studies, Specialized Laboratories, etc. The Executive Council may also constitute Special Board(s) of Studies and academic committee(s) for their guidance.

3. With reference to your above online application No. NMC/UGI/2025-26/000009 for increase in intake of 100 MBBS seats (from 150 seats to 250 seats) **SKS Hospital Medical College & Research Centre, Mathura (U.P.)** the Academic Year (A.Y.) 2025-26, the MARB has reviewed your application along with the documents submitted by your college in light of MARB Regulation- 2023 and UG-MSR- 2023, public notice for inviting applications and Standard Assessment Form (SAF)/ Self Declaration Form (SDF), AEBAS and other reports etc.

2. **It has been decided to permit increase in intake of 50(Fifty) MBBS seats (from 150 seats to 200 seats) u/s 28(3) of the NMC Act, 2019 considering the available infrastructure, faculty and clinical material.**

3. It is to inform you that you and your institution is fully responsible to fulfil and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in Regulation of National Medical Commission (NMC). In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the MARB and the said misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or found

during surprise assessment at any stage during any academic year, this letter of permission shall be cancelled and revoked. Besides, National Medical Commission (NMC) is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law in an event of non-compliance of the rules and regulation of the National Medical Commission.

4. It is mandatory to develop a website on the medical college/ institution and display all the information of the college, courses offered, faculty available and their experience of the last 5 years, students joined, and affiliating university and to display the hospital services, facilities available and the equipment in each specialty, also showing OP and IP census including births and deaths as per the municipal/ Govt. records.

5. Further, in addition to the same the applicant should ensure that the following criteria are met:

- a. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserves the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentation of facts or fraud.
- b. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserves the right to conduct surprise physical/ virtual inspection at any point of time and to take appropriate action accordingly.
- c. It shall be the duty of the institution to abide by all such conditions laid down in the letter of permission and the MARB will have the right to seek such information or cause an enquiry into the matter to verify all such conductions are observed in both letter and spirit.
- d. MARB has to right to take such measures, including issuing warning, imposition of monetary penalty, reducing intake or stoppage of admissions and recommending to the Commission for withdrawal of recognition, against a medical institution for failure to maintain essential standards specified by the Under-Graduate Medical Education Board or the Post Graduate Medical Education Board, as the case may be, in accordance with the regulation made under the Act.
- e. It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regards issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the college were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed in accordance with law against the college.
- f. The medical college/institution shall be responsible for installation and maintenance of AEBAS, close circuit camera, and HMIS, and other Information Technology as prescribed from time to time. The same should be made available to NMC as directed.
- g. The institution is expected to correct all the deficiencies before the next renewal inspection to be conducted by the MARB. MARB reserves the right to cancel the LOP or not to renew the LOP if the deficiencies are not rectified.

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6. It is to inform that Bank Guarantee (BG) is essential element for issuance of LoP and is obligatory on the part of medical institutions to submit the same immediately after receiving the LoP/LoI. In view of this, college is requested to furnish the requisite Bank Guarantee (BG) within 15 days of receipt of this letter.
7. In case your college does not agree with the decision of MARB, it may prefer an appeal within 15 days of LoP Order under Section 28(5) of NMC Act-2019; addressed to Secretary NMC through online mode only as per NMC's Public notices dated 21.05.2024 and 30.05.2024.

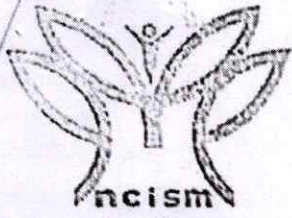

**Subject:-** Grant of Yearly Permission to SKS Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, NH-2, Village Chaumuhan, Distt- Chhata Mathura-281406, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0445) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **SKS Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, NH-2, Village-Chaumuhan, Distt- Chhata Mathura-281406, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0445)** inspection was conducted on **08.04.2025** and **09.04.2025** in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

a) Teaching staff:-

Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is  $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{41}{45} \times 100\% = 91.11\%$  (Excluding Excess)

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**b) Observation by the visitors:-**

i) Proper record for OPD and IPD drug dispensing is not maintained in Hospital Pharmacy.

3) The assessment report was duly placed in the 125<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 09.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulation but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Further the Board also observed that the college is not fulfilling the criteria for extended permission in accordance with regulation 54(2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations 2024, as conditional permission with warning was issued to the college, for the academic year 2024-25. Hence, the Board decided to issue yearly permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) Course in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

**"DECISION"**

4) Therefore, SKS Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, NH-2, Village-Chaumuhan, Distt- Chhata Mathura-281406, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0445) is hereby granted with :-

Yearly Permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and;

5) The aforementioned permission is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-

- I. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

7) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

9) The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.


  
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- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 above, shall be fulfilled.
